

Optix Fax Director for PC is a Windows Service that facilitates the unattended processing of files from local folders (including network folders) as well as remote FTP folders. Incoming files may be indexed into Optix repositories, queues, or workflows.

User-defined rules allow files to be filtered to help eliminate spam faxes. Based on specified criteria, incoming faxes can be directed to backup folders or the recycle bin.

Multiple rules may be specified for different file types, originator, and file size.



Optix Fax Director - Technotes

Optix Fax Director incorporates the following features:

- Monitors folders on a user specified schedule and automatically processes files based on rules set for each folder.
- Each file in a folder may be added to an Optix structured database screen (or table), placed in a queue or it can initiate a workflow route process.
- Files that are processed with Fax Director may be saved to a backup folder, sent to the Recycle Bin or they can be deleted completely, depending on predetermined user-specified rules.
- Multiple configurations may be created for each folder so that files will be processed depending on their type or size.
- Supports interoperability with virtually any FTP server.
- Processing of files occurs completely unattended, but may also be controlled real-time by an end user.
